
Big Area Road Program Is Announced



Shape of things to come is outlined in the above map of the tentative outerbelt highway system around Columbus. This plan was presented to Gov. William O'Neill Tuesday morning by the Columbus Service Department with the plan being endorsed by the Metropoli-

tan Committee, the Chamber of Commerce and the Committee for Development of Greater Columbus.

The large outside line shows the tentative route to come across the river just north of Dublin, proceeding east just beyond Hilliards, and beyond Rome just west of Doughertyrd. It would then continue just north of Urbancrest, east through the edge of Reese and just south of Obetz, proceeding north between Whitehall and Reynoldsburg, south of Westerville and north of Worthington. An alternate route being discussed is shown in the light dotted line closer to Columbus.

Gov. O'Neill has announced three phases of the program costing \$38 millions which include the segment of the northeast expressway from Maynardav north to the city line, the Third-st viaduct and Goodalest from Fourth to Sandusky-st. Part of this program will get underway this year.
